



**Funding for
High-Potential Professors, Researchers, Innovators and Artists
The Second Century Fund (C2F), 2020**

Objective

- (1) To promote and support the creation of new knowledge in the forefront field.
- (2) To support faculty members in conducting academic output and research, publishing the academic works with foreign professors or foreign researchers, and creating innovations or artworks with high-potential professors, researchers, innovators, artists.
- (3) To encourage students of all levels to study and learn with high-potential professors, researchers, innovators, and artists.

Qualifications of the Candidate

- (1) The candidate needs to be a high potential professor, researcher, innovator or artist who possesses international works and affiliates or used to affiliated with a university, or academic/research institute, or professional sector or organization that is known worldwide.
- (2) The candidate needs to own either of the following:
 - (A) **As professor or researcher:** The candidate is required to have at least 10 Tier 1 publications in ISI/Scopus database or international equivalent database within the previous 5 years. At least 5 publications require the candidate's name as the first author, or corresponding author, or the main editor of the publication of book series or book chapter that belong to international publishing house. Or the candidate is required to have articles in book series or book chapter which belong to international publishing house.
 - (B) **As an innovator:** The candidate is required to have won national or international contest awards at least 3 times. And/or the candidate was granted one international award, or one global award.
 - (C) **As an artist:** The candidate is required to have had organized at least 10 national or international exhibitions. One of them needs to be exhibition of international level.
 - (D) The candidate is required to possess works comparable to the committee's regulation which is stated in (A), (B), or (C).

In case the candidate does not meet the above criteria, the candidate can propose his/her reasons to the committee for further consideration.

The Undertakings of the Grantee

In case the faculty/college/institute agrees to work with professor, researcher innovator, or artists, at least the agreement regarding the grantee's undertakings and outputs needs to be consisted of the following aspects:

(1) As a professor or researcher:

(A) The grantee is required to work with faculty members to

(A-1) Publish Tier 1 article in ISI/Scopus database or international equivalent database. In the first year, the grantee shall publish more than or equal to 1 article of Tier 1, and more than or equal to 1 article of Q1. The following year, the grantee shall publish more than 1 article of Tier 1, and more than or equal to 1 article of Q1.

(A-2) Or the grantee is required to be the main editor of a book series or book chapter published in the Scopus database once a year. Or the grantee shall be a co-author of a textbook that will be published and spread widely on international level.

However, the works in (A-1) or (A-2) need to be identified as Chulalongkorn University's affiliation or Chulalongkorn University together with the grantee's affiliate institution in the acknowledgment.

(B) The grantee shall be a mentor and an internal reviewer for faculty members so that they can publish Tier 1 or at least Q1 research paper or academic output in international academic journal. The number of articles is at least 5 per year.

(C) The grantee is required to manage and create network which promotes international publication distribution strategy and to share the grantee's experience and expertise to faculty members and researchers.

(D) The grantee is required to teach or co-teach at least one hour per week in academic course or seminar (Seminar, Journal Club), and be a guest speaker at public lecture at least once a year in order to create academic atmosphere.

(2) As an innovator or artist

A) The grantee is required to create innovation or artwork and to exhibit his works to public in international academic forum at least one time while the grantee is working at Chulalongkorn University.

B) The grantee is required to work as a mentor and internal reviewer regarding innovation and artwork to faculty members so that they can create innovation or artwork and exhibit their works to public in international academic forum at least one time while the grantee is working at Chulalongkorn University.

C) The grantee is required to manage and create network that promotes distribution of innovative and artistic works on international level strategy and to share the grantee's experience and expertise to faculty members and researchers.

D) The grantee is required to co-teach at least one hour per week in academic course and be a guest speaker in public lecture at least once a year to create academic atmosphere.

Details of Funding

(1) Monthly expense within 200,000 THB per month.

(2) Economy class round-trip airfare which the grantee can disburse only the actual amount that the grantee had paid within 60,000 THB per year.

(3) Accommodation expense within 15,000 THB per month.

*In this regard, the rate of monthly expense is according to the committee's regulations. The expense that is not mentioned in (1) (2) and (3) shall be executed according to the committee's consideration.

**In case the grantee is unable to complete his/her working period of any month, the grantee shall be granted funding in the amount according to the grantee's actual workday. And one month is counted 30 days.

***While benefitting from this funding, the grantee shall not receive any funding that is similar to the one that Chulalongkorn University is providing to the grantee.

Duration of Funding

1-2 years (Different duration shall be taken into consideration by the committee.)

How to Apply

The application must be proposed by the dean or director of faculty/college/institute with the approval of the executive committee or research group supported by the university. The application template can be download at <https://bit.ly/2QKUC8b> and has to be submitted to C2F office via CU Lesspaper **at least three month before the start funding date.**

Progress Report

The grantee's performance must be reported and proposed to the committee by the dean or director every 6 months. (The report form can be downloaded at <https://bit.ly/3gwRKqa>)

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
